Details are below for each spring sporting event that will occur at Marcus Whitman. Please share with your transportation department as well as coaches and families regarding spectators expectations.

Spectators attending Whitman Spring Sporting Events

Common spectator expectations:

- Our events are not open to the general public.
- Per NYSDOH, maximum attendance at events will be 200 people. Visiting teams will be permitted 2 spectators per student/athlete.
- Spectators will check in with event staff upon arrival at each event
- Spectators, Team personnel and event personnel must wear a mask 100% of the time.
- Spectators and Student-athletes cannot attend if in the last fourteen (14) days:
 - They have tested positive for COVID-19.
 - Experienced symptoms of COVID-19 that are new or not usual symptoms related to seasonal allergies.
 - Knowingly been in close or proximate contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID -19 or has symptoms of COVID-19.
 - Traveled to a state for more than 24-hours that is affected by NYS Executive Order 205.

Transportation Details - HS Campus

- Track & Field
 - Team buses will drop off students and park in our HS parking lot.
 - Visiting spectators will park in our new parking lot next to the concession stand. This lot is accessed via the bus garage entrance at the bottom of the hill on Baldwin Rd.
- Tennis
 - Team Buses and Spectators will use the main HS parking lot.
 - Tennis Courts are located behind the HS building and are accessed by walking from HS lot.
- Girls Modified Lacrosse
 - Team Buses and Spectators will use the main HS parking lot.
 - The Lacrosse field is behind the HS building beyond the tennis courts and accessed by walking from HS lot.
- Varsity Girls & Varsity Boys Lacrosse
 - Team buses will drop off students and park at the Whitman bus garage.
 - Visiting spectators will park in our new parking lot next to the concession stand. This lot is accessed via the bus garage entrance at the bottom of the hill on Baldwin Rd.

Transportation Details - Gorham Campus

- Baseball
 - Team buses will drop off students and park in the Gorham parking lot
 - Visiting spectators will park in the Gorham Elementary parking lot.
 - Baseball field is located behind the school

Transportation Details - Middlesex Valley Campus

- Softball
 - Team buses will drop off students and park in the Valley primary parking lot via the west entrance
 - Visiting spectators will park in the Valley primary parking lot.
 - Softball field is located behind the school on the west side.
- Boys Modified Lacrosse
 - Team buses will drop off students and park in the Valley primary parking lot via the west entrance
 - Visiting spectators will park in the Valley primary parking lot.
 - Lacrosse field is located behind the school building

Visiting Team Guidelines

- Locker rooms will not be available. Teams should arrive at the game site ready to play
- Bathrooms or port-a-potties will be available at each site.
- Water will not be provided at events. Student-athletes should bring their own water bottle labeled with their full name
- Teams should depart immediately at the conclusion of the event
- Pre-game & post game handshakes will not be conducted
- Sanitizer will be available at score tables at each event site
- All guidelines outlined by NYSPHSAA will be followed which includes expectations for face coverings.
